## ENTRY PROCEDURES for 2010 Design Awards

**Purpose:** To encourage excellence in architectural design, to make the public more aware of the potential of the man-made environment and to honor the architect, owner and builder of significant projects, AIA Buffalo/WNY announces their Design Awards Program.

### Entry Procedure for Award Nominations

#### **I. Categories:**

The following categories will be considered for awards:

- ***New Construction:*** > 25,000 sq ft - freestanding independent building
- ***New Construction:*** < 25,000 sq ft – free standing independent building
- ***Additions & Renovations:*** Modifications to an existing structure
- ***Urban Design:*** Urban design projects completed or planned. Must be of a designed urban environment or urban element displaying multiple design disciplines.
- ***Historic Preservation:*** Projects displaying Design Excellence in the salvage and or renovation of a significant historic structure(s).
- ***Interior Environment:*** Interior projects of a designed interior space.
- ***Unbuilt:*** Commissioned project that are completed through schematic design or beyond.

**Unbuilt Category:** It is intended to extend the Design Awards program to include noteworthy projects that may have been in a design competition or of conceptual in nature. **The entrance fee for this category is \$75.00.**

This category is exempt from photo requirements.

3D drawings and/or computer renderings are strongly recommended.

Submission should provide sufficient entry data for clear explanation of design intent.

## All Categories:

1. Previously submitted projects can be re-submitted for review one additional time after the initial submission.
2. All projects should be recent. The completion of construction should be within the last five (5) years
3. Each project shall be designated and submitted into a category listed above. An award for each category will not be mandated. Jury may choose to award a project in a different category. Multiple awards may be selected in each category.
4. A minimum number of awards are not required from the jury. Work from some years may yield more awards than others.
5. The selection of the jury is determined by the Design Awards Committee and is approved by the Board of Directors. The jury will not be local to Buffalo and preferably not from upstate New York for the most fair and impartial review.
