Professional Excellence Awards

Robert and Louise Bethune Award –

Recognized as the highest award that AIA Buffalo/WNY can bestow on an architect. The Bethune Award will be presented to an individual in recognition of a lifetime of notable contributions to the profession of architecture through practice, mentorship, and community leadership.

Distinguished Service Award –

Awarded to an individual or group who have performed outstanding service to the local AIA Chapter.

Mentor of the Year Award –

Awarded to an individual or group who have inspired and developed architectural students, interns, or architects with professional guidance and wisdom.

Young Architect/Associate Award –

Awarded to an individual or individuals, 29 years to 39 years of age, who have demonstrated exceptional professional promise in technical or design skills.
